Financial Aid Eligibility

All Financial Aid eligibility is calculated based on units required towards completion of your degree. In order to be considered for **ALL** aid options, students would need to be registered in a minimum of **6 degree** required units and if applicable, will need to complete the 2025-2026 FAFSA. ***At no time can the total financial aid awarded in the summer exceed the summer Cost of Attendance. ***

Summer On-Campus Housing Stipends:

All Students who are **registered in a minimum of 6 degree required units** and living on campus over the **<u>Full</u>** Summer term will qualify for a **\$3,000** ON-CAMPUS housing stipend. **(Only offered for the summer semester. This award will NOT roll forward to Fall/Spring semesters)**

Scholarship and Grants:

Graduate: students, please contact the Financial Aid office for an estimate of your scholarship eligibility.

<u>Undergraduate:</u> (MERIT Scholarships are not offered for Summer Courses.)

CCA Scholarship eligibility is based on the completion of the 2025-26 FAFSA. Scholarships are offered based on an already discounted tuition rate for summer and the number of units you are registered in. For undergraduate students who are eligible for CCA scholarship, you could receive the following:

Registered Units	CCA Scholarship Award Amount
3 Units	\$1,500
6 units	\$3,000
9 units	\$4,500

Federal Student Loans:

Students who **enroll in a minimum of 6 degree required units** during the summer may be eligible to receive Federal Direct Loans. This chart refers to the maximum possible loan amounts for the summer semester. **Note: if you are nearing your aggregate loan limits or completing your degree in summer, your loans may be prorated.**
