

CCA 2022 Summer Estimated Financial Aid Eligibility

Students who enroll in a minimum of 6 units during the summer may be eligible to receive Federal Direct Loans. See chart below for typical summer loan amounts. The chart refers to the maximum full loan eligible amounts for the summer semester. **Note: if you are nearing your aggregate loan limits, your loans will be prorated.**

CCA Scholarship eligibility is based on your 2022-23 award eligibility. Scholarships are prorated based upon an already discounted tuition rate for summer and depend on the number of units you are registered in. Any eligibility of CCA and other Institutional scholarships are only available for summer on-campus/online courses (**excludes travel programs**). For undergraduates, students who are eligible for CCA scholarship will receive the following:

Students completing their degree requirements in the summer will also have their federal loan amounts prorated based on enrollment. Eligibility for all federal financial aid will be determined once the student's 2022-23 financial aid file is complete and the student is enrolled.

Undergraduate students may also be eligible for summer Pell awards. ***At no time can the total financial aid awarded in the summer exceed the summer Cost of Attendance.
