

Voter Registration - The Details

Registering to vote is simple and we're here to help. Here's how to use CCA's Voter Registration Portal:

To register to vote, you will need to know:

- Your date of birth,
- Your social security number,
- Your address,
- And preferably your driver's license number or state identification number.

You can use CCA's voter registration portal to register to vote using your local Bay Area address OR your home state address. You cannot vote in both places.

To register to vote, complete a voter registration application on paper or online. CCA's voter registration portal can help you with your application regardless of whether you register on paper or online. It can also be used to request an absentee ballot, find your polling location, and research your ballot.

To register to vote, open a new Chrome browser window on any CCA computer. From CCA's Voting Resources page, navigate to CCA's voter registration portal. Alternatively, scan this QR code to access the portal from your phone:



First, fill out your contact information and click "submit."

Then, if you select "I have what I need to register online," you will be redirected to your secretary of state's website, where you can register to vote using their online form.

When you register online, your secretary of state's voter registration system will search the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) database for your driver's license or identification card number, date of birth, and last four digits of your social security number. If your information is found and you authorize elections officials' use of your DMV signature, an electronic image of your DMV signature will be added



to your voter registration application after you click "submit" at the end of the online application.

If you do not have a driver's license or identification card number, or there is no signature on file with DMV, all of your information will be transmitted to your county elections office; you will need to print the completed application, sign it, and drop it in the red collection box under the voter registration desk at the CCA Library for the CCA Voting Coalition to mail on your behalf. We'll add postage. Your county elections official will contact you when your voter registration application is approved or if more information is needed to confirm your eligibility.

If you select "I will submit my own form," the voter portal will email you a form to complete, print, and mail in. You can complete this process at your convenience. Just drop your form in the red collection box under the voter registration desk in the library for the CCA Voting Coalition to mail on your behalf-we'll add the necessary postage.
